Attractively intense, very fruity and aromatic, with hints of Wisteria flowers and Rennet apples. Gratiot-Pilliere NV Champagne - 12% <i>A blend of 69 % Pinot Meunier, 28% Chardonnay and 3 % Pinot Noir, this elegant champagne has aromas of citrus fruits and fresh apples. Delicate fruit flavours and an elegant biscuity character are balanced by a tangy citrus note.</i>	£45.50
Joseph Perrier NV Champagne - 12% <i>35% Chardonnay, 35% Pinot Noir and 30% Pinot Meunier, with three years of ageing, this vivacious champagne has a delicate nose of green apples and stone fruits. A lively freshness balances the round and elegant citrus fruit on the palate.</i>	£55.00

Lobster Reef Sauvignon Blanc - New Zealand - 12.5% <i>Fresh and aromatic with lively notes of citrus, gooseberry and blackcurrant leaf jumping out of the glass. The palate is concentrated and juicy with a well-rounded and crisp finish.</i>				£33.50

La Linda Bodega Malbec - Argentina - 14% (vg) <i>La Linda Malbec is produced following organic practices from 30 year old Malbec vines grown at 960 metres above sea level. Pitchfork Shiraz - Australia - 14.5% (vg) <i>Time and time again, the Shiraz from Pitchfork punches well above its weight. Vibrant and youthful with a brilliant hue of good depth. Ripe cherry and plum fruits on the nose, with smooth chocolaty influences. The palate displays good depth of fruit concentration, ripe sweet fruit fleshiness in the mid palate and good flavour extension</i>				£38.00
